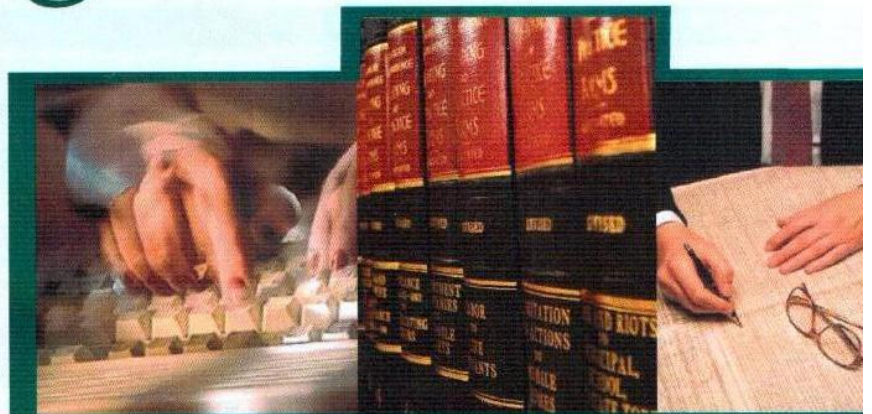

Labour Laws are seen to be complex, sometimes inconsistent, confusing and too many.
